


















What is Step Up?

The first Step Up was held in 2005 as a way to bring students and adults together in a dialogue that was believed to help identify the needs of the youth. We wanted to LISTEN to the youth and give them a VOICE. We then started working towards making Loudoun County the best possible place to grow up!

In 2010, Step Up was transformed into a program that empowers the youth themselves to take positive and impactful actions to make their communities a better place to live, to get an education and to play. Youth identify the issues that matter to them and they TAKE ACTION to create solutions!











How do you Step Up?

- Identify a topic that is important to you
- Research the topic to become educated about it
- Develop and implement an action plan or solution
- Attend an Orientation Session
- Prepare and practice your 5 minute presentation
- Present your work in the preliminary round on Tuesday, March 28, 2017
- The top 10 teams move into the Finals to determine their cash prizes on April 5th, 2017




Loudoun County stopped doing car seat safety checks 10 years ago

Offer FREE car seat safety checks













- 500 car seats safely installed










Peers and Students Taking Action





Judging

- At the Competition, the judges will be evaluating your project on four components:
 - Issue Analysis
 - Solution Quality
 - Community Impact
 - Presentation












Issue Analysis

- Investigate why the problem happens the root cause
- Analyze how it impacts your school or community
- Find out if people have tried to solve this problem before – what roadblocks did they run into?











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Solution Quality



- Create a detailed solution (who? what? when? where? how?)
- Connect the solution to the problem – does it really address the issue?
- Collect data to show how your solution is making/will make an impact on your community



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Community Impact



- PASTA members highlighted 47 volunteer projects the organization had spearheaded.
- Loudoun student creates support website for sexual assault survivors.
- Woodgrove High students organize walk to raise awareness of teen suicide.








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Presentation





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
